REVEREND DR. ROBERT AND MRS. JACQUELINE JEMERSON

Rev. Dr. Robert L. Jemerson, Retired Chaplain Colonel USAF, is an ordained minister of the American Baptist Church. He is a native of Dallas, Texas. He has earned degrees from Bishop College (B.A., 1966) Virginia Union University School of Theology (M. Div.,) 1969, Presbyterian School of Christian Education (M.A., 1970), one year Clinical Pastoral Education at the Medical College of Virginia, and Drew University (D. Min., 2001).

In addition to ministry as a parish pastor, he has experience as a counselor. Reverend Jemerson entered the Air Force as a Chaplain Candidate in 1968. He was the first American Baptist Seminarian commissioned in the United States Air Force Chaplaincy Candidate Program. Rev. Jemerson was called to active duty in February 1971. His major contribution to the Air Force is the establishment of the gospel worship services. Rev. Jemerson is the first and only Black American Baptist Church Chaplain to obtain the rank of Colonel in the United States Air Force. He was the first Air Force Chaplain to receive the highest degree in Prince Hall Masonry, the 33rd Degree. It was received in 1977.

Reverend Jemerson served as the pastor of the First Mt. Zion Baptist Church, Dallas, TX, Union Missionary Baptist Church, Crozet, VA and the Eastminister Presbyterian Church, Richmond, VA. He was the first Black Baptist Minister to receive a Special Dispensation from the Presbyterian Church in America to serve as the pastor in a Presbyterian Church. He also served the Tabernacle Baptist Church and the First Baptist Church in Petersburg, VA, as interim pastor.

Reverend Jemerson is involved in the community as Past President of San Antonio Community of Churches, he serves as a member of the Board of Directors of San Antonio Mission Ministries; National Council of Christians and Jews; Top Church Steeples and served as Chairman of the Board of Directors for the Carver Cultural Center Development Board. He has served two four year terms on the Board of Trustees For Our Lady of the Lake University. He currently serves on the Advisory Board at Wayland Baptist University in San Antonio, Texas, and has served on the Board of Trustees for the Ecumenical Center for Religion and Health. He is a Life member of the NAACP, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, 33rd Prince Hall Mason, Optimist Club of America, Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity, and VIA Metropolitan Transit 2025 Task Force. In 1973, he was awarded the distinction of being one of the "Outstanding Young Men in America" and in 1989 he was the recipient of the American Baptist Churches "Military Chaplain of the Year."

Pastor Jemerson has led Second Baptist Church, community and organizations in many firsts in San Antonio. The Homework at Second Baptist (H.A.S.) Program serves as a tutorial program for underprivileged students in grades one through eight. His "Thanksgiving-In-The-Park" ministry serves to provide much needed clothing and food for needy families, in addition to fellowship between church members and local residents. In collaboration with the "Cactus Pear", he brought for the first time to the Eastside community, members of the San Antonio Symphony, exposing 800 young people to Classical Music. Under his leadership, the "Community of Churches" contributed over \$35,000.00 to Black Churches destroyed by fire, \$9,000.00 to three flood damaged churches and was instrumental in the organization honoring the first Black Layman in its forty year history. Through his leadership, over twenty young adults have attended the National Conference of Christian and Jews' Camp Anytown. He also was instrumental in the selection of their Black honorees, a physician, a senior clergyman and a couple. As a member of the above named organization, he has participated in fund drives that have netted over \$4 million dollars. In October 1998, Reverend Jemerson was recognized for "Outstanding Service" to the Community of San Antonio by the Phi Delta Kappa Sorority Hall Of Fame Award-2001. In 2010 he received the City Public Service "Amazing Energy Award" and the United Communities of San Antonio Brotherhood/Sisterhood "Humanitarian Award."

On a national level, Reverend Jemerson served the Progressive National Baptist Convention as Vice President At Large of the Southwest Region and continues to hold the office of endorser for all the convention's Chaplaincy Services. He is responsible for supervising the ministry of seventy-five chaplains. In December 2001, he was elected the Chairman of the National Association of Military Chaplains. This body oversees the endorsements and ministry for all chaplains (1000+) civilian and military.

Reverend Jemerson is married to the former Jacqueline Locke of Buffalo, NY. They have one son, Attorney Robert Jemerson, Jr., his wife Charita and two grandchildren, Robert III and McKinley.

SPEAKER

Rev. Dr. Robert Diggs, Retired Chaplain Lt. Col, USA Pastor, Tabernacle Baptist Church, Petersburg, Virginia



Dr. Robert A. Diggs, Sr. is a native of Mathews, Virginia. He is the son of Frances V. Diggs and the late Robert E. Diggs of Cardinal, VA. He attended public school there and worshipped in the Zion Baptist Church where Rev. Dr. W. R. Henderson baptized him. Having graduated high school as a State Champion Half Miler, he was recruited by Norfolk State College to run track. He was the CIAA Champion three of four years in the mile or half mile and a member of the NCAA Championship team for two years consecutively.

He received his Bachelor of Science Degree and entered the U.S. Army as a Distinguished Military Graduate and commissioned Regular Army Quartermaster detailed Infantry in 1975. He served as platoon leader, executive officer, S-3 Air, S-3, and Company Commander during his first tour in the military. He was then selected to attend the University of Iowa where he received a Master of Art Degree. His follow-on assignment was at the US Military Academy at West Point where he taught Physical Education for three years and coached track.

Rev. Diggs was called into the Gospel ministry while in command at Fort Hood, Texas. He preached his trial sermon at age 28 under the instruction of the late Rev. Dr. R. A. Abercrombie of the Marlboro Heights Missionary Baptist Church, Killeen, Texas in August 1980. While at the US Military Academy, West Point, New York, he entered seminary at the Nyack Missionary College (Christian Missionary Alliance Seminary) and began work towards a Master of Divinity Degree. He was later transferred to Fort Meade, Maryland where he continued his study at the Howard University Divinity School and received his Master of Divinity Degree in May 1986.

Rev. Diggs received catechetical instruction from Rev. Dr. Olin P. Boyd and was ordained April 1986 by the First Baptist Church of Guilford where Rev. Dr. John L. Wright is pastor. His ecclesiastical endorsement for the ministry of the chaplaincy was from the National Baptist Church USA Incorporated. Having completed all the academic and religious requirements, he applied for a branch transfer to the US Army Chaplain Corps; but he was turned down. He was told that in order for him to become a chaplain he had to be a reserve Captain. At the time, Chaplain Diggs was two months from being promoted to Major, on the Command and General Staff College school's list and already Regular Army. The chaplaincy stated he would have to resign his Regular Army commission, decline promotion to Major and leave the military for one day to be reappointed the next day as a chaplain, Captain in a reserve status.

Dr. Diggs retired from active duty on July 2, 1998 receiving the Legion of Merit; the highest military award given during peace time and signed by the President of the United States. His other military awards include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (4th Oak Leaf Cluster), the Army Commendation Medal (2nd Oak Leaf Cluster), the Army Achievement Medal (2ND Oak Leaf Cluster), the National Defense Medal, the South East Asia Medal, the Kuwait Liberation Medal, The Parachute Badge and the Air Assault Badge.

He is married to Dr. Christine Heath Diggs, and they have three gifts from God; Robert Jr.; Schnequa and Christopher. Reverend Diggs' life grounding text is "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13).
