He is one of five children, which include his twin sister and three older brothers. He was baptized at the age of 6 years old, at the Historic Pleasant Green Baptist Church of Lexington, Ky, where he still is a member. He has been married for over 23 years to the former Margaret Mosley. She is a certified Master Instructor of Cosmetology.
