LIFE: Eunice Idell Williams was born in South Hill, Virginia. In her early teenage years, she moved to Chicago, Illinois and attended high school there. After attending the Cook County School of Nursing for 18 months, she moved to Washington, D.C. at the age of 24 and began a career working for the Department of Defense at Walter Reed Army Medical Center. After meeting and marrying her husband, Nicholas, she traveled with him on his US Army assignments to El Paso, Texas, an Antonio, Texas and continued her employment with the federal government.

MINISTRY AND CHURCH AFFILIATION: Rev. Williams was raised up in the church but feels very strongly that she did not establish a personal relationship with Christ until much later in life. In the very early portion of 2001, Minister Williams heard and heeded the call by God for her to proclaim the Gospel. She preached her initial sermon and received her license to preach the gospel in October of 2001. She was ordained in October 2003 after 18 months of intensive study for the ordination examination. Rev Williams and her husband have been actively involved as a Sunday School teacher and a preacher of God's Good News.

Rev. Williams and her husband were members of Best Grove Missionary Baptist Church, Goldsboro, North Carolina from 2000 to 2006. She attended the Women's Baptist Home and Foreign Missionary Convention and the North Carolina General Baptist Convention's mid-year session.

She sees her ministry as being one outside of the church, reaching out to those less fortunate and the incarcerated population. While living in San Antonio from 1988 to 2000, she eagerly helped with her church's homeless feeding program and nursing home visitation program.

MARRIAGE: In 1977, Reverend Williams met her husband, Reverend Nicholas W. Williams when he was assigned to Walter Reed Army Medical Center. They have been together since 1977 and married since 1980. Rev. Williams and her husband have two sons, David and Todd.

EDUCATION: Reverend Williams attended Mount Olive College for a period of time where she took courses in New Testament and Old Testament studies and Christian Education. She has an earnest desire to continue studying theological topics that will enhance her capabilities to carry out the duties that God has ordained her for.
