### **REV. DR. ARGRA NELL THOMPSON, PhD**

Reverend Argra Nell Thompson, PhD. is the oldest daughter of Liz and late Waco Porter, Jr. (USMC Ret.). Born in Corsicana, TX, while her father served in Vietnam, she traveled the US with her military family. She gave her life to Christ at an early age and was baptized in Texas City by the same Pastor that baptized her father, the Reverend D. N. Benford of the Rising Star Missionary Baptist Church. Reverend Benford is in the Guinness Book of World Records as having pastored the same church of over seventy years. Staying active in church at each of her father's duty

stations, she developed a strongly rooted relationship with God that has gotten her through her life.

Argra Nell joined the Army in 1989 and served for four years. She attended college while raising her five boys and earned an advanced degree in Biblical Psychology. She accepted her calling in to the ministry in Tacoma, WA and preached her first sermon in 2001. She is a proud lifetime member of the National Council of Negro Women, NAACP, and the Disabled Veterans Association. Dr. Thompson has remained active in her community as well as her church for over five decades. Serving in various areas of ministry for over 20 years, her passion is to help young people develop a strong Christ-based foundation and counsel Domestic Abuse survivors.

She is a member of Second Baptist Church where she teaches Youth Bible Study, Vacation Bible School, and is the Youth Ministry Director. Argra currently serves as the President of Singles Participating in Christian Endeavors (S.P.I.C.E.), plays in the Bell Choir (Silver Bells), dances with the Senior Dance Team (Silver and Gold), and is active in two Women's Missionary Union Circles.

As a fourteen year stroke and abuse survivor, Argra is convinced that "God has a healing Word for every hurt imaginable."



#### MR. ANDREW ASANTE, MUSIC CLINICIAN

Growing up, Andrew was always surrounded by music. He played the viola for 7 years and performed in the Lone Star Youth Orchestra in Las Colinas, TX for 4 years. In his junior year of high school, Asante joined his school's choir and was selected for the Texas Music Educator

Association (TMEA) All-State Choir. In the fall of 2021, Asante began attending Texas State University (TXST) as a music education major with a choral emphasis. In his time at TXST, he has sung in 4 different ensembles and has been under the instruction of Dr. Suzanne Ramo-Gechter. He has performed works such as O Fortuna from *Carmina* 

*Burana*, The Robert Ray Gospel Mass, and Considering Matthew Shepard under the direction of Dr. Jonathan Babcock, Professor Craig Aamot, Dr. Joey Martin, and Dr. Craig Hella Johnson.

His leadership roles include being the President and Music Director of the Gospel Expressions Association and Bass Section Leader/Soloist at the First Protestant Church of New Braunfels. When not attending school, Asante sings with the St. Philip Presbyterian Church Choir, the Woodhaven Presbyterian Church Worship Team, and he directs the Divine Grace Church Worship Team in Hurst, Irving, and Arlington, Texas.
