CHURCH ORGANIST: MRS. LA FAYE DUREN

La Faye Carpenter Duren serves as the organist of Second Baptist Church. Her music instruction began under the guidance of the late Hughie Dorn. Music studies continued with the Sisters of Holy Spirit, Sisters of the Incarnate Word, Sisters of Divine Providence, and her mentor Mr. Nelson Armstrong.

La Faye received her degree in music from Our Lady of the Lake University, and continued her studies at the University of Incarnate Word. Additional organ studies were received in Europe. She has studied at Oxford University, Westminster Abbey, St. Paul's Cathedral, St Martin in the Fields, and played on twenty - five of the great organs of England. Additional organ studies were conducted at the former Crystal Cathedral of Garden Grove, California; the National Cathedral of Washington D. C; St. Patrick's Cathedral, New York City; Baylor University, and Trinity University.

Second Baptist Church has recognized La Faye on many occasions for her years of dedicated service to the youth and membership of Second Baptist Church. She is the recipient of the Distinguished Service Award from the Martin Luther King, Jr. Service Guild. She has also received awards from the Chancel Choir, Contemporary Choir, Men's Choir, and the Nanny Helen Burroughs Circle of the Women's Missionary Union.

Mrs. Duren is a classroom teacher at St. Anthony Catholic Elementary School, where she impacts the lives of students daily. During the 2009 – 2010 academic year, she was recognized as Teacher of the Year. She has received awards from Who's Who Among America's Teachers, Archdiocese of San Antonio - Outstanding Leader in Catholic Education, Phi Delta Kappa-Educator's Hall of Fame, Top Ladies of Distinction, Inc., San Antonio Metropolitan Chapter, and 2019 - Women in the NAACP.

On March 16, 2025, La Faye Duren was featured in the San Antonio Express-News. The article titled, "Organists Finds Calling at Historic San Antonio Church", she speaks of the pipe organ as the "King of Instruments", and how she merges classical hymns, African – American Spirituals, and gospel songs. La Faye is quoted in the article saying, "Playing this powerful wind instrument Sunday after Sunday is an honor." "It is a calling."

La Faye Duren is a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., the American Guild of Organists, and the NAACP.

La Faye is married to Korling L. Duren Sr., a staunch supporter of her many goals. They are the parents of Korling L. Duren Jr., and the grandparents of Asha Marlae Duren, Avelina Faye Duren, Juana Andrea Duren, and Anissa La Faye Duren. The support of her brother and sister in law, Larry and Sherry Carpenter, family, Second Baptist Church, and the San Antonio Community is a priceless gift from God.


