While at Boston University School of Theology, she worked as administrative support for the Sustaining Urban Pastoral Excellence Program in Boston, MA., a two million-dollar Lilly Endowment Fund project. Formally, Rev. McCalister was employed in management at Electronic Data Systems.

Rev. 
