The Reverend Dr. Keith William Byrd Sr. serves as pastor of the historic Zion Baptist Church in Northwest Washington, D.C. He was called to serve as the ninth pastor in the church's 161-year history.

Dr. Byrd accepted his call to preach in 1997. He was licensed and ordained at First Baptist Church, Inc. of North Brentwood, Maryland, under the leadership of the late Reverend Dr. Perry A. Smith III.

A gifted preacher, teacher, leader, mentor, and community activist, Dr. Byrd is committed to serving both the church and the broader community. Under God's guidance and Dr. Byrd's visionary leadership, Zion strives to be a family church empowered by the love of Christ to serve the family of God.

In support of this vision, Dr. Byrd has overseen several major renovation projects at Zion, including extensive technology enhancements and improvements to the church sanctuary. He also led the congregation through a five-year Strategic Plan for Ministry, which provided direction in the areas of Christian education, leadership development, evangelism, disciple engagement, diaconate effectiveness, and facility and technology enhancements.

The strategic plan culminated in a merger with the former New Creation Baptist Church in Silver Spring, Maryland. As a result, Zion now serves as one church in two locations.

Dr. Byrd's current denominational leadership includes:

- President of the Progressive National Baptist Convention, Inc.
- Board Member of the Conference of National Black Churches
- Board of Conveners of the Baptist Network
- Immediate Past President of the Baptist Convention of D.C. and Vicinity

A native of Washington, D.C., Dr. Byrd earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Maryland, College Park; a Master of Divinity degree from the Howard University School of Divinity; and a Doctor of Ministry degree in Church Leadership from Wesley Theological Seminary. He is also a member of the Morehouse College Board of Preachers.

Dr. Byrd is supported in life and ministry by his wife of 32 years and two adult sons.

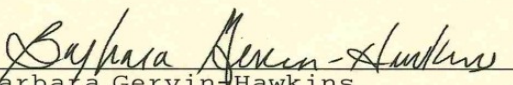

WHEREAS, In addition to meeting the needs of his congregation, Reverend Jemerson has held leadership roles in a number of religious organizations, including the Community of Churches for Social Action and the Progressive National Baptist Convention; moreover, he served as a United States Air Force chaplain and retired with the rank of colonel; a 33rd Degree Prince Hall Mason, he is a member of several service organizations, and he has further given of his time and talents to the Carver Development Board and VIA Metropolitan Transit 2025 Task Force; in all his endeavors, he enjoys the love and support of his wife of 56 years, Jacqueline, and he takes great pride in their son, Robert Jr., and his wife, Charita, and their two grandchildren, Robert III and McKinley; and

WHEREAS, Robert Jemerson has served his congregation with compassion, grace, and wisdom, and he may indeed reflect with pride on his exemplary tenure with Second Baptist Church as he looks forward to the next exciting chapter of his life; now, therefore, be it

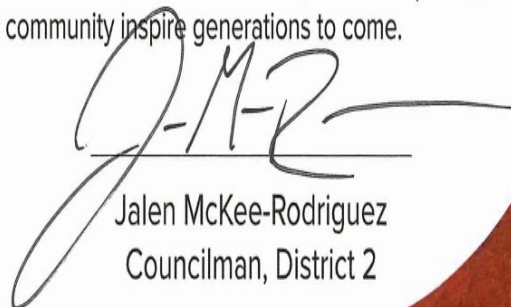
